Notice of Application Confined Feeding Operation & Water Licence

Stonybrook Farms Ltd. has filed Application RA23031 with the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) to obtain an approval to expand a confined feeding operation (CFO) on the W½ 14-41-27 W4M in Lacombe County, Alberta. The application is to expand an existing dairy to 450 milking cows, 70 dry cows, 500 replacements and to construct a new heifer barn and a solid manure storage pad.

Stonybrook Farms Ltd. has also filed an application with Alberta Environment and Protected Areas (EPA) for a licence under the *Water Act* to divert water up to a maximum of 7,500 cubic metres annually from a groundwater well located at SW 14-041-27 W4 for agricultural (confined feeding operation) purposes. The production interval of the well is from 36.6 m to 48.7 m.
