Thanks for the update Arie. I will update your application information to reflect the change in size of the catch basin. I have not yet reviewed all of the information in your application to be able to make a determination regarding whether or not groundwater monitoring will be required.

Please do not do any construction of CFO facilities until such time as a permit is issued. Under AOPA that construction without a permit is considered to be unauthorized construction which has compliance implications.

Received your voicemail yesterday, thanks for the info. Makes a lot more sense. Guess when they dug the catch basin they made it bigger than I figured.

So I is possible to have the catch basin size changed in my permit to 31m long, 21m wide, and 1.8m deep?

Will a leakage monitor system still be needed for the catch basin as well? Catch basin is dug for a while already, but not lined yet because it was not clear what was exactly necessary for a monitor system.
