Decision Summary RA21043 / Double T Cattle Co. Ltd.

The Natural Resources Conservation Board (the Board) has received seven requests for review (RFR) regarding NRCB Decision Summary RA21043, Double T Cattle Co. Ltd. The decision summary approved an application to convert a swine confined feeding operation (CFO) to a beef feedlot CFO, and was issued on May 17, 2022. The CFO is located at NE 15-42-25 W4M in Ponoka County.

Six of the RFRs were from directly affected parties. One RFR was from a party not listed as directly affected in the approval officer's decision; the Board will first reconsider status. All the RFRs met the June 8, 2022, deadline set out in the approval officer's cover letter. Copies of the RFRs are attached.

Any party who **has an adverse interest to the outcomes requested or positions presented in the RFRs** may submit a written rebuttal for the Board's consideration. Rebuttals must be provided by email to laura.friend@nrcb.ca by **June 15, 2022**. Rebuttals filed after the deadline will not be considered.
