**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Poultry barn complex (30.6 m x 108 m) including:
  - layer barn (84 m x 13.5 m) with attached manure pad (10.7 m x 13.5 m)
  - pullet barn (72.6 m x 13.5 m) with attached manure pad (10.7 m x 13.5 m)

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition three.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

**Construction conditions**

1. Construction completion deadline

The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the barns and their associated manure storages prior to November 1, 2025. Upon written request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

2. Concrete

The concrete used to construct the liner (the floor of) barns and their associated manure storages must meet the specification for category D (solid manure – dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.”

The co-permit holders shall provide a completion report, prepared by a qualified third party, to the NRCB confirming the specifications of the above concrete liner requirements. This documentation must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition three, or by a later date stated in writing by the NRCB.



3. Post construction inspection

The co-permit holders shall not place manure or livestock in the barns or their associated manure storages until NRCB personnel have inspected them and stated in writing that they have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this approval.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
