Re: Darcor Holstein Inc. application RA22027

Please consider this email as my rebuttal to the appeal on above stated application, reasons stated below:

County of Wetaskiwin's CURRENT and PRIOR MDP states: No new CFOs within 1.6 km of Coal Lake.

This application is for a new CFO and should not be considered a conversion. For many reasons, including prior operation was a hog farm not a dairy, it was abandoned over 12 years ago, current buildings will not be utilized for the dairy.

Applicant has been approved for another CFO , one that would be more suitable as there is much less chance of any contamination to the lake at that location.

Consider prior feedback from residents in this area, Battle River Watershed Alliance, City of Wetaskiwin, City of Camrose, Ducks Unlimited, County of Wetaskiwin, etc.

The view from this side of the lake indicates how very close this CFO would be to Coal Lake.

Lagoons are susceptible to failure. Whaling could occur. They can become damaged by the manure spreading equipment causing a leak in the liner. Contamination to the lake would be quick considering that there is only a treeless steep hill in between the lagoon and the lake.

Coal Lake is the water source for a city of 12000 people.

It is beautiful and enjoyed recreationally by many.

The physical and mental well being of people living all around the lake. The water quality in Coal Lake is currently clean and healthy.

For reasons above please do not allow this CFO to be built on this lake bank..
