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Meghan and Bill,

Please find a Project Update Addendum attached for the Town of Canmore Debris Flood Retention Structure. This Addendum includes an updated description of the project design and information requested by the NRCB in a letter to the Town of Canmore dated February 28, 2019, and during conversations between NRCB and Town of Canmore staff. The project design herein represents the final design that will be used for permitting and procurement.

The basic design, function, and location of the Structure has not changed from the design presented in the EIA, and the information provided in this Addendum is intended as a supplement the original 2016 Application (NRCB Application No. 1601) and the February 2019 Project Update.

I will be sending this document with a summary cover letter to all of the Treaty 7 First Nations next week and will also provide a follow-up letter describing the status of the project to First Nation and Metis groups notified at the request of Infrastructure Canada.
