Further to your e-mail of February 14, 2024, I wish to advise you that the proposed Tent Mountain Pumped Hydro Energy Storage (TM-PHES) Project is a mandatory activity pursuant to Schedule 1(c) and 1(l) of the Environmental Assessment (Mandatory and Exempted Activities) Regulation. Tent Mountain Pumped Hydro Limited Partnership is required, pursuant to Section 44(1)(a) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* (EPEA), to prepare and submit an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report for this project. The EIA report is to be prepared in accordance with the provisions of Division 1 of Part 2 of EPEA.
