WHEREAS

Glacier Power Ltd. (Glacier) has filed an application with the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) and the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (EUB) for approval to construct and operate an 80-megawatt, run-of-the-river hydroelectric facility (the Project) on the Peace River upstream of the Dunvegan Bridge; and

WHEREAS

the NRCB and EUB have previously issued a Joint Preliminary Notice of Application.
