



Request for Board Review (RFR) of an Inspector Enforcement Order

Instructions

1. **Eligibility.** The owner/operator is the only party eligible to request a Board Review (RFR) of an inspector's enforcement order.
2. **Jurisdiction.** The Board's jurisdiction in Alberta to review an enforcement order is set out in section 41 of the [Agricultural Operation Practices Act](#) (AOPA).
3. **Deadline.** The NRCB must receive an RFR by the deadline specified in the enforcement order. The AOPA Administrative Procedures Regulation does not allow consideration of time extension requests or late submissions.
4. **Public Documents.** RFRs and attachments are public documents.
5. **Submission.** Submit this form and any attachments by email to Laura Friend, Manager of Board Reviews at laura.friend@nrcb.ca. Contact her at 403-297-8269 for assistance.
