RE: Compliance Directive CD 24-01 Extension Letter

On July 30, 2024, Cecil Klassen requested an extension in writing from the NRCB to extend the deadline date of CD 24-01, from August 1, 2024, to October 1, 2024, to complete the closure cleanup of pen 12. This email was further to a telephone discussion July 22, 2024, between Cecil and myself. Cecil advised clay had been hauled in to reconstruct the berm in pen 12 located along the east side of the surface run-off interceptor, a requirement of Directive # 2 in Compliance Directive CD 24-01. Due to wet weather conditions, the berm has not been completed and pen 12 has not been decommissioned. More time is required to meet the requirements of CD 24-01. Cecil also advised that pen 12 is currently empty.

On July 11, 2024, Approval Officer Sarah Neff deemed the application complete for an NRCB permit for the construction of pen 11 (150' x 1000'). The additional information section of the Part 2 application reads "Decommission north pen and rebuild berm before August 1, 2024".

As progress has been made towards obtaining a permit for pen 11, reconstructing the berm and decommissioning pen 12, I am granting an extension until **October 1, 2024**, to meet the requirements of Compliance Directive CD 24-01.

In the interim, Beaver Valley Cattle Co. Ltd., shall mitigate any possible risks to the environment and potential nuisances to any affected neighbours.
