

In consideration of Decision Summary RA24013A, Authorization RA24013A is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

Swine Quarantine Barn – 22.6 m x 4.9 m x 1.2 m deep (74 ft. x 16 ft. x 4 ft.)

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that Act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions, the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents included with filed Application RA24013 and RA24013A.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition 2.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with testing, recording, and reporting requirements (this includes post construction reports).

Construction conditions

- 1. The concrete used to construct the liner of the new swine quarantine barn must meet the specifications for category B (liquid manure shallow pits) and category C (solid manure wet), in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas." The co-permit holders shall provide written confirmation, from a qualified third party, confirming that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specification.
- 2. The co-permit holders shall not allow livestock or manure in the new swine quarantine barn, until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
- 3. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the new swine quarantine barn prior to November 30, 2026. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.



This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with previously issued Approval RA16034A. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

Authorization RA24013 is therefore cancelled and is no longer in effect, unless Authorization RA24013A is held invalid, in which case the previous permit will remain in effect.
