**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Dairy barn– 95.7 m x 35.6 m with an in-barn manure pit (3.6 m x 3.6 m x 3.6 m deep)
- Earthen manure storage facility (EMS) – 61 m x 61 m x 3.7 m deep

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that Act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions, the site plan, building plans, engineering reports and other attached documents included with filed Application RA25004.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions 2 and 5.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with recording, and reporting requirements (this includes post construction reports).

### **Construction conditions**

#### Dairy barn

1. The concrete used to construct the liner of the dairy barn must meet the specifications for category B (liquid manure shallow pits), and category C (solid manure-wet), in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.” The co-permit holders shall provide written confirmation confirming that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specifications.
2. The co-permit holders shall not allow livestock or manure in the dairy barn until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
3. The co-permit holders shall complete the construction of the dairy barn prior to November 30, 2027. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.



Earthen manure storage (EMS)

4. The co-permit holders shall provide the NRCB with written confirmation from a qualified third party that provides confirmation of the constructed dimensions of the EMS, including inside end and side slopes.
5. The co-permit holders shall not allow manure in the EMS until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
6. The co-permit holders shall complete the construction of the EMS prior to November 30, 2027. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
7. The co-permit holders shall immediately cease construction of the EMS, and contact the NRCB if the water table is observed to be one metre or less from the bottom of the liner of the EMS.

This registration becomes effective immediately. The registration conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
